Transform Leatherhead Public Consultation



If you could make one change to Leatherhead Town Centre, what would it be? Mole Valley District Council is working with Nexus Planning to seek the views of residents, visitors and businesses on how Leatherhead could be transformed.

Working in partnership with local businesses, residents and other key stakeholders, Transform Leatherhead is a project that is looking to give the town the vibrant, flourishing town centre it needs.

The Masterplan is being prepared to consider the future role of the town centre and identify how Leatherhead can achieve the potential it deserves as an important historic market town in the heart of Surrey. It will consider how the built environment, including the transport infrastructure, may need to be redesigned to develop a viable programme of re-development that best meets the needs of businesses and residents - not just in Leatherhead, but in the catchment areas of Fetcham, Bookham and Ashted as well.

The work will concentrate on how economic, environmental, social and cultural aspects of the town centre can be improved. A key element of this will be to agree a vision for Leatherhead town centre with residents and businesses, from which short, medium and long term actions can be agreed.

A key part of the Masterplan process involves considerable engagement and major consultation with businesses and residents and a wide range of public, private and not for profit sector partners, so that all stakeholders have a voice in developing the future plans for the town.
