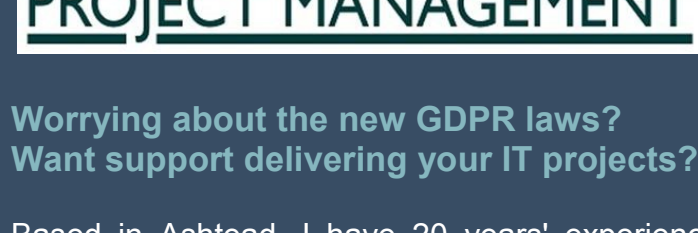

Heard about GDPR?

Trying to ignore it? Well, don't!

Firstly, what does GDPR stand for? **General Data Protection Regulation**.

When does it start? It will apply from 25th May 2018.

Do I have to do anything? Yes, definitely!

GDPR is all about making sure any personal data that you keep in your business (electronic and paper) is secure and necessary. Every business in the EU has to comply.

Answering these questions will get you thinking along the right lines for compliance:

- **What data do you keep about other people?**
- Do you have permission to store this information or is it part of complying with another regulation?
- **Can you justify keeping certain information about people? For example, is it necessary to know the ethnicity of someone?**
- Where is this data stored? Is it on a file server, in the cloud or on various laptops?
- **Are all these locations safe? For example, if you keep data on a laptop, what would happen if the laptop was stolen? Does your server have strong passwords?**
- How many people can access this information on your network? Is it just restricted to certain members of the team or can everyone see it? If you keep paper files, are they in a locked room with restricted access?
- **Do any 3rd parties store information on your clients?**

If you can happily justify keeping limited amounts of personal data, and you're confident that it's secure, then you're well on your way to GDPR compliance.

But if the above questions have just raised more questions, then now is the time to take action to get your worries addressed. If you have a data breach or you don't comply with this new regulation, then the fines are pretty scary. **So get started now!**
